Bicycle officers need to ride whenever and wherever they are needed. Proper training is essential to an officer's on-the-job performance and safety. The Police Cyclist training is the result of input from a group of police bike patrol experts and is based on needs identified by members of active police bike patrols. The course content is diverse and relevant, focusing on the bicycle as transportation and as a tool for law enforcement. Special attention is given to bicycle patrol procedures and tactics. This demanding class involves over 20 hours of on-bike time to develop and improve riding skills, and includes training of E-Bikes.

Required Equipment:

- Duty Bicycle and Safety Equipment (helmet, gloves, eye protection)
- Repair kit (patch kit, spare tubes, wrenches, etc.)
- Comfortable riding attire (padded pants/short strongly recommended)
- Bug spray/sunscreen/water bottle
- Note-taking material
- Gun belt and body armor are optional.
