This **basic**, hands-on, evidence processing and collection class is geared toward patrol officers who don't have immediate access to a crime scene unit or who need to do a quick process for preservation and new detectives that have little or no experience processing evidence or minor scenes. This is not an Evidence Technician Certification course, but it will cover the analysis of a crime scene, what to look for, and how to document, preserve, and collect evidence.

Attendees will have an opportunity to process vehicles and mock crime scenes.

Equipment needed:

Camera, tripod, flashlight, crime scene scale and evidence processing kit to include: box of rubber gloves, black powder, dusting fingerprint brush, distilled water, evidence packaging bags, glassine envelopes, lifting tape, fingerprint cards, scissors, and sterile swabs.

*Please bring enough supplies to allow multiple repetitions and sufficient practice on various techniques and exercises.

This class will be taught by area detectives with a combined total of over 25 years in investigative work, either as a Detective, Crash Investigator, or Evidence Technician.
