This is a fast paced, exciting class taught by local law enforcement officers that also instruct our public safety professionals on vehicle operation! No need to worry about using your car as we will provide the vehicles for your teen.

The teens will take part in classroom instruction involving traffic laws, accident scenarios and risky driving behaviors. They will also have hands on driving instruction on evasive maneuvers, braking, vehicle control in wet/slippery conditions, situational awareness, and driving decision-making under stress.

This 8-hour class is designed for the teenage driver that already has their driver's license (ages 16-19).
