Expert instructors not only teach the important topics, concepts, and strategies necessary for leadership and managerial success — but also discuss how to effectively implement these strategies, apply the concepts, and lead situations where the problems are real and agency performance outcomes are critical.

#### **Prerequisites:**

Participants should have at least two years of supervisory experience and be prepared to complete upper-class level (i.e., 3rd / 4th year) university course work. This means that students are able to:

- Write a research paper
- Perform arithmetic operations and understand elementary algebraic notation
- Read, comprehend, and retain assigned materials based on textbooks, professional journals, trade magazines, and other sources
- Schedule time to complete out-of-class reading and writing assignments

Completion of Supervision of Police Personnel is highly recommended.
