This is a comprehensive course in the applied science of tactical medicine and rescue techniques. The knowledge obtained regarding high-threat rescue techniques and tactical operation medical treatment modalities utilizing TECC will empower the tactical rescuer to become adaptable and successful in a high-threat environment.

This is a physically demanding course. Extended outdoor scenarios are part of the program which will be in all types of weather. Please dress appropriately. It is generally recommended that students should not have limited duty restrictions. Students also must attend all classes. Due to safety concerns and safety checks being conducted prior to class, <u>students will not be allowed to arrive late or leave</u> early.

We understand that many EMS providers do not have access to tactical equipment. We suggest you approach your local law enforcement agency for potential loaner equipment.

Mandatory Equipment:

BDU/EMS type uniform pants with pockets (in good repair). Shorts are not allowed for safety reasons. Long sleeve shirts are strongly recommended.

Sturdy boots, belt, tactical type gloves, safety glasses, hearing protection, rugged flashlight, Kevlar tactical helmet (or snowboarding/climbing/riot type helmet is ok)

Note: A limited quantity of used police riot helmets with face shields available for use. Paintball type mask with throat protection, water and/or sports drinks

Suggested equipment:

Ballistic tactical vest (students have used a fishing type vest in the past for training purposes), knee pads, tactical belt with holster, training gun (solid plastic "blue" or "red" gun only – no toy or real guns allowed), rain gear, bug spray and sunscreen

ALL REAL OR LIVE WEAPONS OF ANY TYPE are forbidden in the class.

Class Admission Criteria:

Due to the sensitive nature of the law enforcement information provided, students must meet one of the following two criteria to be admitted into this course:

- A current employment or affiliation with a federal, state or local law enforcement agency, or
- be a State of Wisconsin-licensed EMT-Basic, EMT-Intermediate
 Technician, EMT-Intermediate, EMT Paramedic, RN or MD, <u>and</u> have law
 enforcement, fire department, ambulance service, or hospital emergency
 department affiliation.

<u>Due to the high demand for this course, please be respectful and notify us as early as possible if you need to withdrawal for any reason so we may fill your seat. Also, only a maximum of four student per agency will be allowed.</u>
