Often officers believe they have little or no value within their organization except to make arrests, write reports and issue citations. The reality is, an organization's true strength is their personnel that are interacting with the public numerous times every day and are either improving the organization's brand or damaging it. And, command level officers don't have enough time in a day to repair those damaged relationships which are negatively impacting the agencies brand and credibility. This course was created to empower officers to be the leaders the community expects during these difficult times, while at the same time helping them develop ways to grow their leadership long after the class ends.

This class is designed for anyone who wears a uniform and/or carries a badge (even civilian personnel) that has NO formal rank or direct supervisory responsibilities at their agency to help them realize and embrace their leadership roles.
