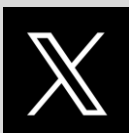

Online Predator Investigations require unique skills that are not taught to the average law enforcement officer. This training teaches officers the entire process from assuming an undercover online identity to courtroom testimony.

In this course, officers will learn how to:

- Establish an online undercover profile
- Recognize online predators
- Communicate with online predators
- Control situations while maintaining an undercover identity
- Arrange meetings with suspects
- Perform surveillance on suspects
- Plan and execute search warrants
- Maximize computerized evidence
- Document undercover actions
- Testify effectively in court
- Preserve physical and mental well-being
- Conform your investigation to Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) standards

Equipment needed:

Instructors:

Detective Jicha (retired), a 26-year-veteran at the Waukesha Police Department (WKPD), worked undercover for 15 years conducting more than 1,500 undercover operations including numerous online predator investigations.
