Bicycle officers need to ride whenever and wherever they are needed. Learn to ride like a pro, avoid crashes, and use your bike to foil the bad guys every time. This essential training combines Emergency Vehicle Operations for bike officers with patrol procedures, tactics, scenarios, and basic bike maintenance and on-the-road repairs. Be prepared for a demanding class of over 20 hours of on-bike time which will develop and improve your riding skills!

*This course can include training of E-Bikes and will include a certificate.*

### Required Equipment:

- Duty Bicycle and Safety Equipment (helmet, gloves, eye protection)
- Repair kit (patch kit, spare tubes, wrenches, etc.)
- Comfortable riding attire (padded pants/short strongly recommended)
- Bug spray/sunscreen/water bottle
- Note-taking material
- Gun belt and body armor are optional.
