The *Firearms Instructor Workshop series* provides advanced training opportunities for firearms instructors with each session focusing on a different aspect of firearms training.

This workshop will focus on – Modern Fundamentals & Fixing Struggling Shooters.

This course was designed to challenge legacy firearms training concepts and replace them with modern, evidence-based approaches to performance shooting. In today's law enforcement environment, instructors who continue to evolve—adapting to advancements in biomechanics, vision, and performance science—are the ones producing officers who can perform under real-world pressure. We will break away from legacy ideas and instead introduce a more effective framework built on foundational principles that apply to all shooters and environments. Instructors will leave with a clearer understanding of what drives real-world performance when it counts.

Beyond fundamentals, this course directly addresses one of the biggest gaps in law enforcement training: truly improving struggling shooters. Many remediation programs fail because they rely on the same flawed concepts that created the problem in the first place. This class provides instructors with practical, repeatable methods to diagnose shooter issues, apply corrective strategies, and build confidence in officers who have historically struggled to qualify or perform. By integrating modern insights into stress, performance anxiety, and learning behavior, instructors will gain tools to not only fix shooters—but to elevate their entire program. The result is more competent officers, more effective training days, and ultimately, better outcomes on the street.
