This course is designed for investigators responsible for handling overdose death investigations following the initial patrol response. It is intended for full-time investigators or those assigned to carry cases through all four phases of an overdose death investigation. The course specifically concentrates on the final two phases of the investigative process.

Some of the topics include:

- Overdose death investigation phases 1 and 2 overviews
- Recommendations for initial patrol response
- When to access a phone without a warrant
- Undercover communication with source of supply
- Rapid locating of drug source
- Cellular device tracking resources
- Pathology and toxicology breakdown
