The *Firearms Instructor Workshop series* provides advanced training opportunities for firearms instructors with each session focusing on a different aspect of firearms training.

This workshop will focus on – Movement & Agility Training.

This instructor workshop is designed to equip firearms instructors with the knowledge and methods to teach students how to move and shoot effectively on the range and on the street. Instructors will learn how to progressively build officer movement skills over a period of time. They will learn how to teach movement principles, core movement skills, improve shooter performance with basic “change of direction” range drills, and then finally progress to conducting range training and teaches *true reactive agility* - training officers to react and move decisively in unpredictable directions without prior planning, while delivering fast and accurate handgun fire. Instructors will not only refine their own movement and shooting skills, but leave with the ability to confidently build, run, and coach movement-based training that drives shooting performance in critical incidents.

Equipment Required:

- Handgun, holster, min 3 magazines, 400 pistol rounds
- Duty gear, body armor, eyes/ears
