Attendees will receive hands on training with different type of ID's required by State law, and how to detect fake ID's. Attendees will learn methods to enforce laws inside and areas surrounding these establishments. Attendees will also learn the importance of underage alcohol enforcement, alcohol & tobacco decoy programs, and what is involved in a decoy program.

New information in reference to ACT 73 will also be covered. Attendees will be given direction as to how to perform inspections at licensed businesses.
