Time is critical in exigent case like child abductions, suicidal subjects, hostage/barricade situations and others. Knowing what is available and how to get the data to resolve the situation could have a life-or-death outcome. This course is designed to provide you all the information you will need to properly obtain data in exigent cases from pinging, phone records, hot-lining phones and more.

This is an essential course for any patrol officer or investigator who is managing an exigent case where phone and social media data is involved. Obtaining data in exigent situations is a critical and potentially life-saving tool for law enforcement. However, most officers and investigators are not aware of all the information and resources available to them in exigent cases.
